# **Solar System Objects**

The **Sun** sets at 8:16 PM; Astronomical Twilight begins at 9:37 PM

The Moon is at 51 % illumination; Moonset at 12:18 AM (8/23/15) at AZ 253

At sunset, watch for **Saturn** and the **Moon** almost in a single FOV at AZ 190

Look for **Neptune** after 10 PM in Aquarius in the Southeast

Look for **Uranus** around Midnight in Pisces in the East

# 10 Lunar Objects, beginning around 10 PM

Rupes Recta (and just next door) Craters Thebit A and B

Dorsa Smirnov (and if you are still thirsty) Crater Beer

Crater Cassini's inner craters, and the shadow inside Crater Delambre

Circular Formation called **Humboldt**, seen during this libration

Montes Alpes and Vallis Alpes, near the terminator

The rays coming out of Messier A

## 4 Double Stars All in a Row in Capricorn, the "Sea Goat"

Alpha 1 and 2, Beta 1 and 2, Rho A and B, Omicron A and B

# Galactic Messiers (and a glob, just for fun)

M 31, M 33, M 51, M 63, M 64, M 81, M 82, M 94 (and M13, the wonderful globular cluster!)
